

and a stone; then S 67 $\frac{1}{2}$ E about 10 poles to a stake in the original line (Dukes) ; then North 262 poles to the beginning, containing 197 acres more or less.

The second tract being apart of the Dowery tract laid off to Elvira Duke deed in the division of the lands of L. L. Duke deed and bounded as follows, to-wit: Beginning on a stone and 2 post oaks the beginning corner of the first described tract; then South 161 poles to a stake on the South side of the pike; then with M. Whittles lines N 82 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 40 poles and 8 links to a stone in Whittles' line then North 154 $\frac{1}{2}$ poles to a stake in the said dower line; then with same N 88 W. 40 poles to the beginning, containing 40 acres.

To have and to hold said boundaries of land to the said second party his heirs and assigns fully warranting the title to same as completely as I as Executor am authorized to do except that part of the last mentioned tract occupied by the Turnpike road the part used for said road being only a Quit Claim

It is further agreed that this conveyance carries with it the benefit of a lien or contract entered into by Wm. Hazelip and S. S. Longabaugh for gas, oil and minerals dated May 12th, 1891, so far as the same involves the before mentioned lands, hereby transferred but no further, and a lien is hereby retained to secure the payment of the purchase notes and interest before described.
