Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars cash in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and do hereby convey to the party of the second his heirs and assigns a certain parcel of ground lying and being in Edmonson county in the town of Rocky Hill and on the East side of the Brownsville road and bounded as follows to wit: Beginning on a corner of the land formerly owned by R. T. Hudson thence runnint withhis line S 60 E 220 feet to a stone thence N 11 E 160 feet to a stone thence N 88 W 220 feet to a stone thence S 3 East 60 feet to the beginning also a small piece adjoining the first and beginning on the beginning corner of the first described tract thence S 2 E 50 feet to a stake thence feet to a stone the 2nd corner to the first tract thence N 60 W 220 feet to the beginning being a small strip purchased from R. T. Hudson.
