 Beginning at white oaks in Penny fork just
 above the mouth of Cat Tail branch, thence
 running N 22 W 308 poles to a stake in a line
 John Barriers, then or now Procter McEntires
 Laines 1335 acre survey, then with the
 line N 67 W 180 poles passing the corner
 at 120 poles to a stake near the Mammoth
 cave road, then N 74 poles to a forked white
 oak crossing a branch 152 poles in the
 white oak fork thence down the same to the
 mouth of Penny, then up Penny to the Begin-
 ning containing three hundred (300)
 fifty acres. Timber on said lands to consist
